Topic: Roman Britain

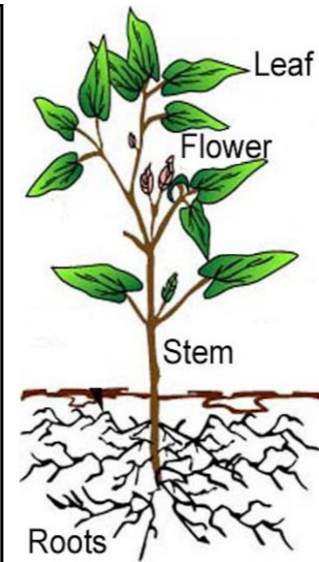
- Draw a Roman soldier. Can you label all of the armour the soldier is wearing?

Topics:

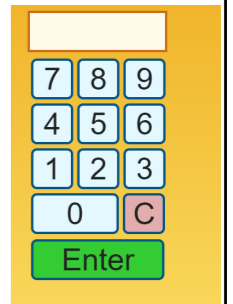
- Choose someone in your family. Write a character description of them. Don't forget to write about their appearance and personality.
