

Year 4 Homework Autumn Term 2024

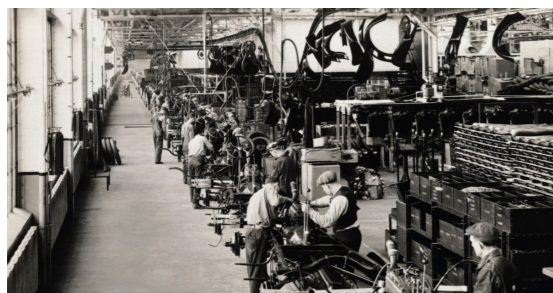
This overview gives you some ideas of how to keep on learning at home. I have set you some challenges to complete for all of the subjects we look at in class, or the challenges might revisit prior learning.

History

Science

- How to look after electrical items
- Different types of electrical items

English

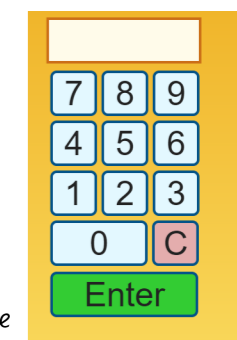
In English this term we have been focusing on the novel 'Captain Underpants'.
