At St James' C of E Forest Pre-School and Nursery, we have embraced the Forest School approach to teaching. This is a child-centred inspirational learning process. It is a long-term program that supports play, exploration and



supported risk taking. It develops confidence and self-esteem through child-inspired, hands-on experiences in a natural setting.

We are blessed with outstanding outdoor grounds for both nursery and reception. Our Forest school 'rewilding' project has inspired our children to develop a deep and meaningful connection to the world and an understanding of how they fit within it.

Our Forest Pre-School and Nursery offers a high quality, structured early years' curriculum. This ensures our children make the best transition to school with strong foundations in early reading (phonics), writing and maths. The strong blend of educational approaches helps learners develop socially, emotionally, spiritually, physically and intellectually. Our qualified teacher works with families and external support agencies to ensure all individual children's needs are met. At the end of the Pre-School year, our children leave nursery equipped with the skills required for a formal curriculum.

Booking

Please apply for a place by contacting the school office on 01254 698335. Once you have completed and returned the nursery application form you will be contacted to arrange a visit. You will then be provided with an early years' agreement form to complete and return after which we will provide your child's start date.

The agreement form confirms your child's attendance for the following term. Places must be booked in advance to ensure adequate staffing levels. Please be aware that attendance at our Forest Pre-School and Nursery does not guarantee your child a place at our primary school. If you wish your child to attend St James' C of E Primary School when they reach statutory school age, you will need to apply in the usual way.
